The Christopher Columbus Scholarship Fund was founded over 30 years ago by a group of Italian Americans with the mission of giving back to the community of York County by investing in the visions of its youth. The organization has awarded over \$200,000 in scholarships to hundreds of students since 1990. They chose the namesake, Christopher Columbus, a 15th Century Italian navigator who is credited with discovering the America's, for the character qualities embodied by the accomplishments of this historic figure. The Christopher Columbus Scholarship Fund wishes to celebrate students who display critical thinking skills, creativity, collaboration, communication, good citizenship, character, ambition, 21st-century skills, technological literacy, entrepreneurship, community involvement, and a vision for success.

Applicants must be high school seniors, residents of York County at the time of application, and must have been accepted to an institution of higher learning. The scholarships have no age restriction. They are available to all York County residents regardless of race, creed, color, religion or national origin. The scholarships will be given to York County students based on academic potential and where financial need is the principal criterion. Scholarship committee judges will determine the recipients. Applications are available through the guidance offices of all York County high schools and on the website after December 1, 2023.

Two Essays (250-300 Words) will be needed to complete this form.

- Please upload a document that answers ONE of the following prompts. (250-300 Words)

 - Would you rather make a lot of money at a job you don't love, or make a living wage at a job that makes you happy and fulfilled? (There is NO correct answer, just make sure to support your opinion)
